DEEP BLUE LAVENDER - Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote'



PINELEAF PENSTEMON - Penstemon pinifolius



This low, creeping penstemon features tubular, scarlet-orange flowers with yellow throats. The prolific blooms rest atop soft, green needle-like foliage, covering the plant throughout the midsummer months.



CARE: Penstemon varieties prefer not to be overcrowded and prefer maximum heat and sun exposure. Avoid enriching the soil around these finicky plants — it will shorten their life span. This semi-evergreen can be slow to establish, so be sure to weed around it regularly to improve establishment.

Plant Maintenance by Season

AINTENANCE TASKS	PLANT
SPRING (AFTER FIRST GROWING SEASON)	
Cut back old growth or winter damage before new growth begins to show.	Autumn Sapphire Sage, Blonde Ambition Blue Grama Grass, Chocolate Flower, Deep Blue Lavender, False Indigo, Giant Sacaton Grass, Maximilian Sunflower, Pineleaf Penstemon, Prairie Red Coneflower, SIlver Salvia, Sunset Hyssop, Switchgrass
Divide mature plants in early spring every 3 years, as needed.	Pineleaf Penstemon, Fringed Sage
SUMMER	
Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms and/or minimize self-seeding.	Chocolate Flower
Pinch back tips by 1 inch to promote busy appereance and new blooms.	Maximilian Sunflower
Once established, deadhead before blooming to encourage compact growth.	Fringed Sage
Water sparingly once established.	Giant Sacaton Grass, Maximilian Sunflower, Sunset Hyssop
FALL	
Leave last round of blooms to self-seed and/or to provide food for birds.	Chocolate Flower, False Indigo, Maximilian Sunflower
Do not prune or cut back! Plant susceptible to winter damage if pruned. It's best to wait until spring.	Deep Blue Lavender, Fringed Sage, Sunset Hyssop
