This six pack of full sun, low-water perennials is comprised of late-blooming flowers to keep your garden looking full and bright late into the season. Bright yellow Black-Eyed Susans complement sunny Dwarf Fall Red Asters, with a bronze and green Little Bluestem grass to round out this six pack.

The classic Black-Eyed Susan features a dark central disc surrounded by a bright, golden ray of petals above stiff, hairy stems and dark green foliage.

CARE: Easily grown in well-drained soils when planted in full sun. It is considered a short-lived perennial that typically survives 4-6 years, but it will spread by seed. Rudbeckia plants that become taller or bushier than desired can be cut back to 6" to generate fresh growth and maintain size.




This compact Aster forms a short, rounded clump of narrow, glossy, dark green foliage covered by densely packed clusters of magenta to crimson-red flowers.

CARE: Give this plenty of room to grow. It is susceptible to powdery mildew, a disease that can be prevented with good air circulation. Keep in mind it spreads easily and can be used as ground cover.

LITTLE BLUESTEM GRASS - Schizachyrium scoparium N



This native grass' as blue-gray pastels in the summer and exhibits bronze tones in the fall with white fluffy seed

CARE: This highly adaptable grass is tolerant of sunbaked locations and poor soil of all varieties, but is ill-suited for shady, wet soils, which will lead to poor structure and floppy growth.

Plant Maintenance by Season


MAINTENANCE TASKS	PLANT
SPRING (AFTER FIRST GROWING SEASON)	
Cut back old growth or winter damage to 4 inches before new growth begins to show.	Black-Eyed Susan, Little Bluestem Grass
Divide mature plants in early spring every 3 years, as needed.	Dwarf Fall Red Aster
SUMMER	
Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms and/or minimize self-seeding.	Black-Eyed Susan
FALL	
Leave last blooms to self-seed and/or feed the birds come winter.	Black-Eyed Susan, Little Bluestem Grass
