The blue-green stems of the Little Bluestem grass turn a rich mahogany red in the winter, maintaining their color throughout the colder months. Enjoy these engaging grasses all season long!

CARE: Easily grown in well-drained soils when planted in full sun. It is considered a short-lived perennial that typically survives 4-6 years, but it will spread by seed. Rudbeckia plants that become taller or bushier than desired can be cut back to 6" to generate fresh growth and maintain size.


MAINTENANCE TASKS	PLANT
SPRING (AFTER FIRST GROWING SEASON)	
Cut back old growth or winter damage to 4 inches before new growth begins to show.	Blue Fescue, Blue Grama Grass, Little Bluestem Grass
Divide mature plants in early spring every 3 years, as needed.	Blue Fescue
FALL	
Leave last blooms to self-seed and/or feed the birds come winter.	Blue Fescue, Blue Grama Grass, Little Bluestem Grass
