ADDITIONAL INFO: Adaptable to a wide range of growing conditions. Once established, only requires occasional watering to grow and flower successfully.

2. MOJAVE SAGE - *Salvia pachyphylla*

ADDITIONAL INFO: Thrives in lean, dry soils with little nutrients. This plant requires well-drained soils, and will not tolerate soils that are constantly wet. Mulch with a thin layer or not at all to prevent excessive crown moisture.

3. PARTRIDGE FEATHER - *Tanacetum densum* var. *amani*

Mature spread 8-12"
-  Blooms late spring to summer

ADDITIONAL INFO: This drought-tolerant plant is able to thrive in a variety of growing conditions and soil-types, except for soils that are constantly wet. This plant is "evergreen", and does not need to be cut back in the spring or fall.

Plant Maintenance by Season

MAINTENANCE TASKS	PLANT
SPRING (After first growing season)	
Cut back old growth or winter damage in mid to late spring.	Kannah Creek® Buckwheat, Mojave Sage
“Comb out” or remove dead foliage.	Partridge Feather
SUMMER	
Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms and compact growth, or to minimize self-seeding.	Kannah Creek® Buckwheat, Partridge Feather
FALL	
Leave last round of blooms to self-seed and/or to provide food for birds.	Kannah Creek® Buckwheat, Mojave Sage
Do not prune or cutback! Plant susceptible to winter damage if pruned.	Partridge Feather
