1. COREOPSIS JETHRO TULL - *Coreopsis* 'Jethro Tull'

QTY. 3



Mature height 18-24"
Mature spread 15-20"

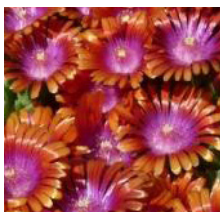


Blooms early
spring to summer

ADDITIONAL INFO: Prune lightly in the early spring to promote new growth and/or to manage appearance. Prefers lean, well-drained soils with moderate moisture levels. Plant is susceptible to root rot in poorly-drained soils. Can be a short-lived perennial so be sure to let to go to seed.

2. FIRE SPINNER® ICEPLANT - *Delosperma* 'P001S'

Mature height 4-6"
Mature spread 12-15"

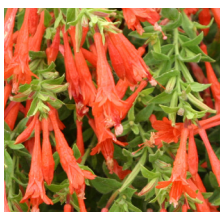


Blooms summer to fall

ADDITIONAL INFO: This succulent thrives in poor quality, well-drained, sandy or gravel soils. Do not add compost to the soil around this plant. Mulch with gravel or not at all. It is important to water consistently during the first growing season in order to establish an extensive root system.

3. ORANGE CARPET® HUMMINGBIRD TRUMPET - *Zauschneria garrettii* 'PWWG01S'

Mature height 4-6"
Mature spread 18-24"



Blooms summer

ADDITIONAL INFO: Grows well in full sun but can appreciate some afternoon shade. Does well in inorganic mulch and amendments such as squeegee. Avoid planting in areas that collect water.

4. REGAL TORCH LILY - *Kniphofia caulescens*

QTY. 1



Mature height 24-30"
Mature spread 24-30"



ADDITIONAL INFO: Torch Lilies are sun lovers, and can grow in any well-drained soil. When blooms are forming, a little extra water is appreciated.

5. WALKER'S LOW CATMINT - *Nepeta faassenii* 'Walkers Low'

Mature height 1-2'
Mature spread 18-24"



ADDITIONAL INFO: When provided with a well drained location and plenty of sun, this plant will thrive and repeatedly bloom throughout the summer. A very low maintenance plant.

6. WINDWALKER® PENSTEMON - *Penstemon x mexicali* 'PWIN02S'

QTY. 3



Mature height 15-18"
Mature spread 15-18"



ADDITIONAL INFO: This penstemon variety prefers not to be overcrowded, and does best with maximum heat and sun exposure. Avoid enriching the soil around these finicky plants - it will shorten their lifespan. This semi-evergreen plant can be slow to establish, so be sure to weed around it regularly.

Plant Maintenance by Season

MAINTENANCE TASKS	PLANT
SPRING (After first growing season)	
Cut back old growth or winter damage in mid to late spring.	Coreopsis Jethro Tull, Orange Carpet® Hummingbird Trumpet, Regal Torch Lily, Walker's Low Catmint
Divide mature plants in early spring every 3-4 years, as needed.	Walker's Low Catmint, Windwalker® Penstemon,
If spring weather is rainy, place a gallon milk jug with the bottom cut out over the plant to keep the ground around it dry. Leave the top off the jug so the plants don't overheat in the sun.	Fire Spinner Iceplant®
SUMMER	
Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms and compact growth, or to minimize self-seeding.	Walker's Low Catmint, Windwalker® Penstemon
Water sparingly once established.	Fire Spinner Iceplant®
FALL	
Leave last round of blooms to self-seed, to provide food for birds, or for winter interest.	Coreopsis Jethro Tull, Orange Carpet® Hummingbird Trumpet, Walker's Low Catmint

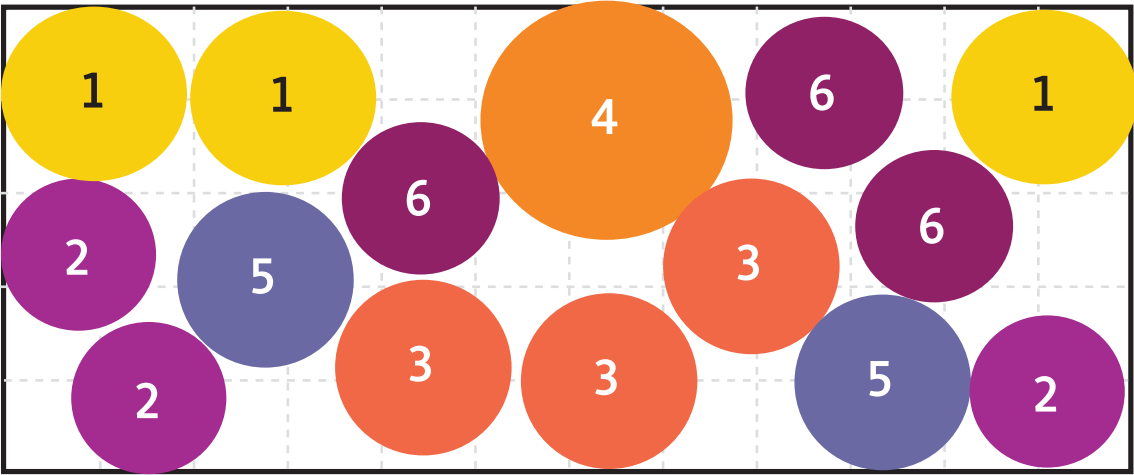

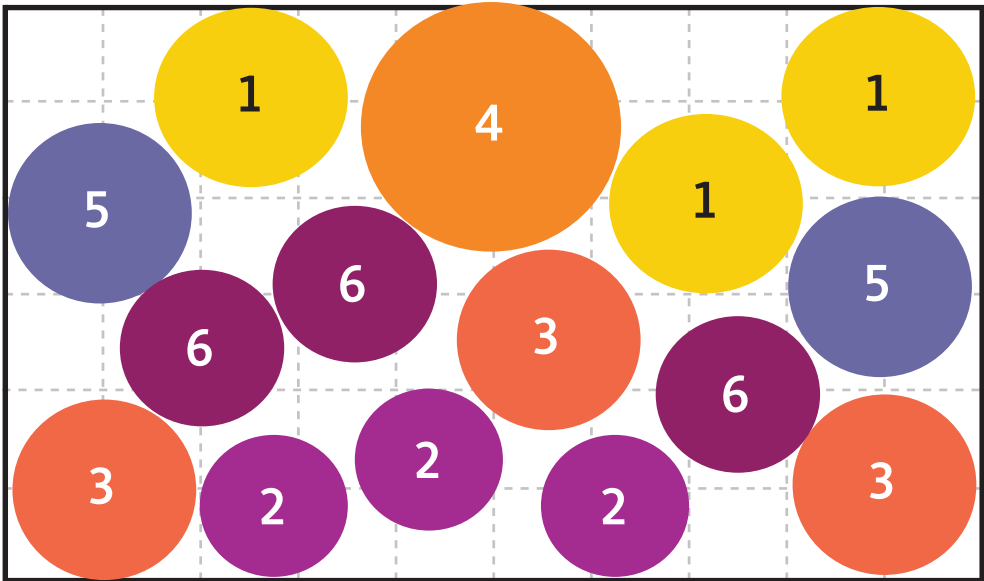
