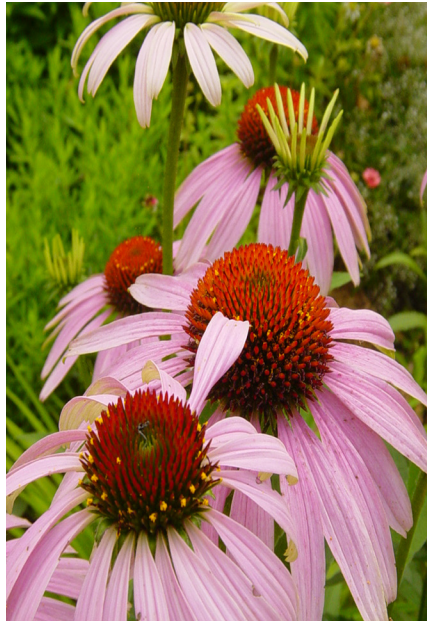


Nine Pack: Magenta Meadow

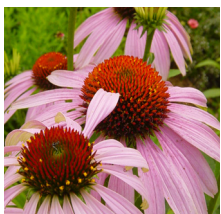


Blooms summer to fall

ADDITIONAL INFO: One of the more drought tolerant Gayfeather varieties. Well suited for sandy, alkaline soils that are well-drained and not overly rich. May stay dormant into late spring.

2. PURPLE CONEFLOWER - *Echinacea purpurea* 'Magnus'

Mature height 2-3'
Mature spread 18-24"

ADDITIONAL INFO: Division is not recommended due to its long tap root.

3. SONORAN SUNSET® HYSSOP - *Agastache cana* 'Sinning' PP#13673

Blooms summer to fall

ADDITIONAL INFO: This drought-tolerant plant is able to thrive in lean, fast draining soils. Amend soil with inorganic squeegee to improve drainage. Reduce water after the first year.

Plant Maintenance by Season

MAINTENANCE TASKS	PLANT
SPRING (After first growing season)	
Cut back old growth or winter damage in mid to late spring.	Gayfeather, Purple Coneflower, Sonoran Sunset® Hyssop
SUMMER	
Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms and compact growth, or to minimize self-seeding.	Purple Coneflower
FALL	
Leave last round of blooms to self-seed and/or to provide food for birds.	Gayfeather, Purple Coneflower, Sonoran Sunset® Hyssop
Do not prune or cutback! Plant susceptible to winter damage if pruned.	Sonoran Sunset® Hyssop
